

PUBLIC HEARING TOWN OF NASHVILLE
Wednesday, February 21, 2018, 6:00pm – 7:00pm

MINUTES:

1. Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance: Chairman James Anderson called the meeting to order and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.
2. Roll Call: Also present was Supervisors Wesley Ginter, Tom Vollmar and Clerk/Treasurer Sandy Frank. Others totaled 12.
3. Open Public Hearing: Wesley Ginter made a motion to open the Public Hearing, Tom Vollmar second. Motion carried.
4. Public Comment: James explained that the Town Planning Commission had just closed their meeting, and that zoning had been discussed. The Commission made a unanimous motion to turn the Town of Nashville Zoning over to the Forest County Zoning Department. Bob Ebben commented that the Town Zoning signs would need to be taken down. Pam LaBine from Forest County Zoning stated that wording contained on the signs is correct even if the zoning is turned over to the County. Neil Schallock commented that he is for the Zoning being transferred to the County. A discussion was held regarding mining, and if the tribal lands are under zoning laws. Pam LaBine commented that a Town of Nashville County Board Supervisor is always on the Forest County Zoning Committee, and that the County never goes into closed Session, the meetings are always open. The Town will retain the driveway permits. Fire numbers are issued by the County.
5. Close Public Hearing: Tom Vollmar made a motion to close the Public Hearing. Wesley Ginter second, motion carried.
6. Adjourn: Wesley Ginter made a motion to adjourn the Public Hearing, motion carried. Time was 7:00 P.M.
