

TOWN BOARD MEETING

Wednesday October 17, 2018, 7:00 P.M.

Nashville Town Hall, 1076 Hwy 55, Crandon, WI

MINUTES

1. Call to Order/Pledge of Allegiance: Chairman Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:10 and the Pledge of Allegiance was said.
2. Roll Call: also present were Supervisors Ginter, Vollmar and Clerk/Treas Frank. Others totaled 42.
3. Public Comment: None
4. Approval of Clerk's Minutes from September 19th Regular monthly meeting and October 8th Budget Workshop: Supervisor Ginter made a motion to approve the minutes from the September regular monthly meeting and the October 8th budget workshop. Second by Supervisor Vollmar, motion carried.
5. Approve Treasurer's Report for Sept. 30, 2018: Motion by Supervisor Ginter to approve the Treasurers report, second by Supervisor Vollmar, motion carried.
6. Reports from Town Officials: Supervisor Vollmar declared that he is not going to run for reelection next term. The town thanked Vollmar for his hard work.
7. Action Items
 - a. Jungle Lake Snowmobile Trail
 - i. Public Appearance by Snowmobile Club: the Club is requesting the town to allow better access to snowmobile traffic when plowing Jungle Lake Road. The club is asking for this to allow accessibility of the snowmobilers to get to the businesses in the town.
 - b. Black Lane Right-of-Way Variance – Ken Waldvogel: the town is agreeable to a 10 foot variance to the 33' setback requirement from the center of the town road. The town agrees to work with the county to give leniency on the normal setback requirements to allow for a building to be located within the setback.
 - c. Bishop Lake Public Access – Ken Waldvogel: Mr Waldvogel is working on preparing an easement.
 - d. Cemetery Survey and work: Pitts are still has questions, Chairman Anderson will meet with them again to go over the questions.
 - e. Amend Budget for zoning wages, N. Building updates, Transportation Budget: Supervisor Vollmar made a motion to amend the 2018 budget as follows; cleaning wages \$500.00, Zoning wages \$220.00, Fica \$55.00, Town Hall \$8000.00 and transportation \$5000.00 for a total of \$13,775.00 to be transferred from the contingencies account to the respect accounts listed. Motion was second by Supervisor Ginter, motion carried.
 - f. Short Lane: motion by Supervisor Ginter to approve the abandonment of Short Lane. Second by Supervisor Vollmar, motion carried.
 - g. Placement of convicted sex offender in the Town of Nashville: citizens of the Town were in attendance to voice their concerns of the safety of our citizens with the placement of a violent Sex offender in our township. The citizens asked the town to initiate a petition opposing this action, and the town complied.
8. Future Agenda Items & Meeting Dates: Budget Hearing: budget workshop will be Monday October 22nd @ 5:00 pm (North Hall), Budget hearing Thursday November 1st @ 7:00 pm (North

Hall), November regular town board meeting November 28th @ 7pm (South Community Center).

9. Correspondence for Town Board Action: Supervisor Ginter presented a letter from Don & Char Scott requesting the town to consider adding and maintaining an additional 547' of road on Valician Shores Drive going Southward. Chairman Anderson will prepare a response informing the Scotts of Town Road standards.
10. Outstanding Claims for Approval: September Checks & auto withdrawals as shown on the September check register presented: Supervisor Ginter made a motion to approve the September checks and auto withdrawals as shown on the September check register, second by Supervisor Vollmar. Motion carried.
11. Adjourn: motion by Supervisor Vollmar to adjourn the meeting, second by Supervisor Ginter. Motion carried. Time was 9:19 pm.
