

TOWN OF NASHVILLE
AN ORDINANCE
PROHIBITING DEPOSIT OF RUBBISH AND STONES ON
HIGHWAY RIGHT OF WAY

The Town Board of the Town of NASHVILLE, County of FOREST,
State of Wisconsin do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to throw or deposit
any weeds, sod, brush, cans, glass, gravel, stones, boulders, machinery,
garbage or other waste or rubbish in or on the right of way of any highway
located in the Town of NASHVILLE, FOREST County, State
of Wisconsin, without written permission of the Town Board of the Town
of NASHVILLE.

Section 2. Penalty. Any person violating any provision of this
ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, forfeit a sum not to exceed
fifty (\$50.00) dollars, besides costs and in default of payment thereof
be imprisoned in the County Jail until said forfeiture and costs are
paid, but not to exceed thirty (30) days.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after
one week from the date of passage and posting of this ordinance and
proof of such posting is filed in the town records by the Town Clerk.

The foregoing ordinance was adopted at a regular meeting of the
Town Board of the Town of NASHVILLE on MARCH 14 1985.
