

## ORDINANCE #5152012-1

### A JOINT ORDINANCE TO REGULATE BOATING UPON THE WATERS OF CRYSTAL LAKE AND PRESCIBING; PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Townships of Langlade, Ainsworth (Langlade County) and Nashville (Forest County) do jointly ordain as follows:

#### **Section I: Applicability and Enforcement**

- (a) The provisions of this ordinance shall apply to the waters of Crystal Lake located in The Townships of Langlade and Ainsworth in Langlade County and the Township of Nashville in Forest County.
- (b) This chapter shall be enforced by the officers of Langlade and Forest County Sheriff's Departments; and any other officer having jurisdiction.

#### **Section II: Intent**

The intent of this ordinance is to provide safe and healthful conditions for the enjoyment of aquatic recreation consistent with public rights and interests, and the capability of the water resources.

#### **Section III: State Boating and Safety Laws Adopted**

State boating laws as found in ss.30.50 to 30.71, Wis. Stats, are adopted by reference.

#### **Section IV: Definitions**

- (a) "Slow No Wake" means that speed of which a boat moves as slowly as possible while still maintaining steerage control.

#### **Section V: Hours of Operation**

No person shall operate a motor boat or personal water craft faster than "Slow No Wake" during the hours of 6:00PM to 10:00AM local time on Crystal Lake.

#### **Section VI: Posting Requirements**

The Crystal Lake Association shall place and maintain a synopsis of this ordinance at all public access points within the jurisdiction of the respective Townships pursuant to the requirements of NR 5.15 Wis. Admin. code.


**Section VII: Penalties**


Wisconsin State boating penalties as found in Wis. Stat. 30.80, and deposits as established in the Uniform Deposit and Bail Schedule established by the Wisconsin Judicial Conference, are hereby adopted by reference and all references to imprisonment deleted.


**Section VIII: Effective Date**
