**Forest County**

The Town Board of the Town of Nashville, Forest County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s.349.11 Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11 Wis. stats., effective June 23, 2011, speed limits on certain Town of Nashville town highways are reduced or modified as follows: North Cole Road from County Highway B north to the town of Crandon town line will be reduced to 45 mph.

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No persons may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60. Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on June 23, 2011

The town clerk shall properly post as required under s. 60.80. Wis. stats.
