

AMENDED ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF A PUBLIC
BOAT LANDING WITHIN THE TOWN OF NASHVILLE

Whereas, it has come to the attention of the Town Board of the Town of Nashville, that large gatherings are taking place at the boat landing on Crystal Lake located within the Town of Nashville which constitutes a nuisance to surrounding property owners, a danger to those who participate as well as to innocent bystanders, and

Whereas, the Town Board of the Town of Nashville in the interest of protecting and preserving the health, safety and welfare of all persons in the Town of Nashville, have deemed it desirable to ammend an adopted ordinance to regulate activities as well as hours during which the public boat landing can be used by the general public, now

Therefore, be it ordained by the Town Board of the Town of Nashville, Forest County, Wisconsin, pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes, Secs. 60.22(3), 60.10(2)(c), and 61.34(1), as follows, to-wit:

Section One: INTENT:

It is the purpose of the Town Board of the Town of Nashville, Forest County, Wisconsin, to regulate the activities at and the hours in which the public boat landing located on Crystal Lake within the Town of Nashville is open to the general public in order that the health, safety and welfare of all persons located in the town of Nashville, residents and visitors alike, may be protected.

SECTION TWO: BOAT LANDING HOURS REGULATED:

(a) The public boat landing located within the Town of Nashville shall open at 6:00 A.M. each and every day and shall close at 11:00 P.M.

(b) It shall be unlawful for any person to congregate or to otherwise make use of the public boat landing located on Crystal Lake within the Town of Nashville other than the hours described above.

(c) It shall be unlawful for any person to exceed a speed limit of five (5) miles per hour on said town access landing road, consume alcoholic beverages after sunset, use loud stereos, shampoo pets, wash cars, and liter at the landing.

(d) illegal drugs and abusive language prohibited at all times.

SECTION THREE: ENFORCEMENT:

(a) The provisions of this ordinance may be enforced by injunction in any Court of competent jurisdiction.

(b) Any person who shall occupy or utilize the public boat landing at times other than the hours set forth above, or engage in activities prohibited as set forth in Section Two sub (c) and sub (d), shall be deemed guilty of committing a public nuisance and such may be abated through measures provided for by law.

(c) Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance may be fined not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$100.00 and each day such violation accrues shall be considered a separate offense.

SECTION FOUR: CONFLICTS:

Any ordinance in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent that said conflict exists, be and the same, is hereby repealed.

SECTION FIVE: EXCLUSIVITY OF PROVISIONS:

All applicable provisions of this ordinance are independently exclusive and should any section or provision be declared invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction it is the intent of the Town Board of Nashville that any section or provision so declared shall be severable from and shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the ordinance.

SECTION SIX: FORCE AND EFFECT:

This ammended ordinance shall take effect and shall be in full force and effect from and after passage and publication as provided by law.
